Invented in 1932

The boards are made of:

1. Millions of hard sisal fibres from naturally grown plants.
2. High tensile steel wiring.
3. Staple-free bullseye and clip wiring system.
4. Removable number ring for rotation to extend the playing life.

Champion Choice
